# Credit history - Everything you need to know



Your credit history can affect you even after 5 to 7 years. You may not be aware of the impact your default payments may create in the future. We created this simple blog with all the basics you need to know about your credit score, report, and credit defaults.

#### Credit History Basics

#### 1. What is Credit Score and Report?

A credit score is a calculation of your credit loans, time period and repayments of such loans in the past. This score can be from 0 to 1200.

A credit report contains important information about yourself (like your address and other basic details) as well as your actual credit history. This is important for your future loan providers.

#### 2. Credit Defaults

You may have delayed paying your utility bills a few years ago. Consequently, this default goes into your credit report and score while staying there for five years.

If you have not made payments even after you have been notified by your lender, this default passes on to a debt collector and could remain in your credit history for up to 7 years. Therefore, it is important to ensure that you pay your debts on time.

#### 3. How Does This Affect Future Loans?

Your future home loan providers could reject your home loan application because of your defaults.

Furthermore, you can view your credit report free of cost, once a year.

#### 4. What about an Incorrect Listing?

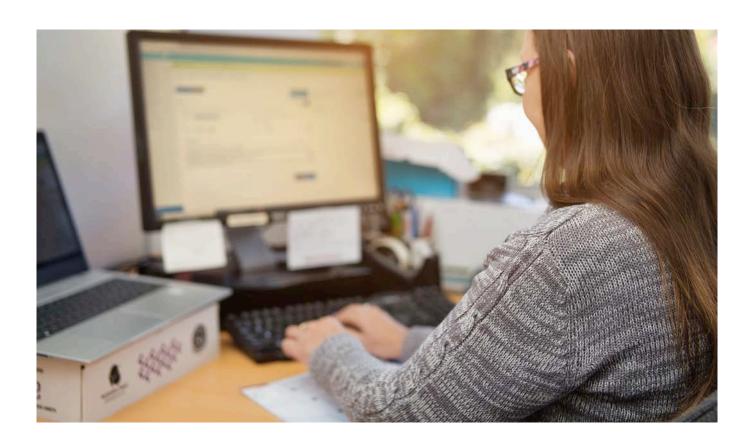
Incorrect listings can occur for a variety of reasons. You may not have been notified properly about your repayments or your payments may not have been processed in time. As a result, you may have an incorrect listing on your report. Here is what you can do to change an incorrect listing.

#### 5. How Reliable is Credit Repair?

Credit repair companies promise to make all the negatives from your credit report go away. Since it is illegal for them to even advertise this, it is important for you to check all the important information. Furthermore, you could possibly fix your credit score by yourself.

# How to find a great property manager

#### 1. Good Communication

Firstly, good communication! This is a critical factor in a successful relationship between rental providers/landlords and their property manager. Ideally, all inquiries from the tenants or landlord should be answered within 24 hours. You want someone who is easy to contact and clear with any issue that might arise. Furthermore, your agent should be able to provide you with accurate, clear, and concise documentation regarding your property to ensure compliance with the RTRA legislation.

#### 2. The Focus Should Be On You

The property management team's style of customer service is critical. Is your Property Manager's primary focus to ensure that they are maximising your income and optimising capital growth? Are they helping you achieve your investment goals while offering a high level of service? Will you be allocated a single Property Manager that will deal with all your investment property needs? At Calibre Real Estate, we have a single Property Manager to handle your property. That way, your Property Manager will know the ins and outs of your property like the back of their hand.

#### 3. Rely on experts

It's integral that the agency you select invests in training to ensure that they are up to date with the latest legislative requirements and best practice policies. Here in Queensland, our local industry body is the Real Estate Industry Queensland (REIQ). REIQ accredited agencies have undertaken and are committed to continuing professional development and ongoing training. To search for REIQ accredited agencies, visit their website.

#### 4. Don't Focus On Fees Only

Fees are only part of the story. Smart landlords consider this a factor but weigh up other facets of property management. If your investment is not managed effectively, it could be costing you thousands of dollars every year. It could also leave you exposed to unnecessary and potentially costly risks. If you feel your property isn't being handled as well as it should be, it can seriously affect your investment.

#### 5. Not All Fee Structures Are The Same

Fees can vary between 3% and 8%. Know what's included and uncover any omissions that could cost you down the track. Prior to signing with an agency, make sure you get details around fees – including any potential hidden fees.

#### 6. Digital Transparency

If this is important to you, seek out a company that offers an online portal where you can track rental payments, tenant requests and complaints, maintenance expenses, and legal documents, rather than relying on monthly or quarterly reports.

#### 7. Ignore Online Reviews

Finally, don't base your judgment of a Property Manager on their online reviews. Take the time and have a chat with multiple Property Managers to find the one that you feel most connected to and confident with.

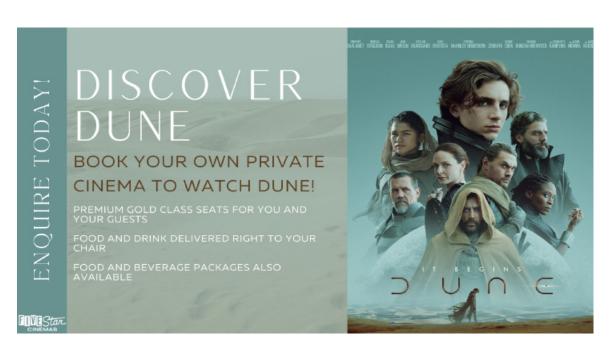

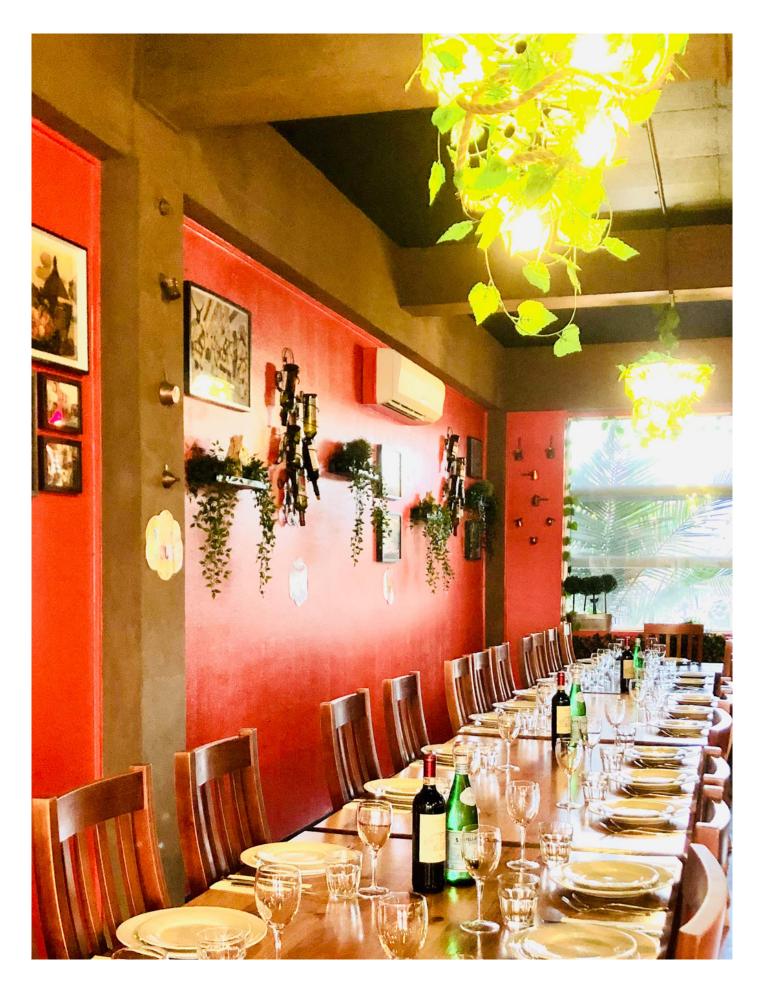

- Splosh vanilla essence
- 100 g dark chocolate, melted

#### HOW-TOS: STYLE YOUR BED LIKE A PRO

You can't deny the satisfaction of having a perfectly styled bed. When you're busy, it's easy to skip making your bed. However, there is nothing better than coming home after a busy day to a beautifully made bed – you will feel relaxed, and your room will look tidy. A little effort will be rewarded with great satisfaction! That is why today we will be sharing with you our secret formula to style your bed flawlessly.



#### What you need for the perfectly made bed

- Fitted sheet
- Flat sheet
- 4 Pillows & Pillowcases
- Quilt & Quilt cover
- Mattress protector
- Decorative pillows & throw

#### How to style the perfect bed

#### Step 1: Materials

First, you'll need to choose all of the above items. There are many different types of bed linen so make sure you feel the texture of the material. Remember, you are aiming to have the best possible night's sleep.

#### Step 2: Mattress Protector

A mattress protector should be purchased. Mattresses are worth a lot of money and, if you get the mattress dirty, it is a lot harder to clean. The mattress protector protects the mattress from sweat and accidental spills on your bed. Therefore, keeping your bed clean at all times!

#### Step 3: Fitted Sheet

Next, use a fitted sheet. You want your fitted sheet to be tight so that it isn't moving around at all during the night. We like to fit at the top first followed by the end. Creases won't be visible as the quilt will cover any imperfections. A styled bed is not only about the aesthetic. It is an entire package from looks to comfort.





#### Step 4: Top Sheet

Put on a top sheet. Lay the top sheet evenly over both sides of the bed with the top aligned with the top end of the bed. This will mean that there is enough leftover at the end of the bed to tuck in and create corners. To create a fancy showroom look, fold the top of the sheet halfway down.

#### Step 5: Quilt

Place a quilt on the bed. This is the same as the top sheet – make sure you centre the quilt so that there is the same amount on both sides. Align the top of the quilt with the top end of the bed. This ensures that the quilt covers you completely if needed at night. There is nothing worse than waking up from your sleep and feeling cold. Now fold the top edge to halfway then fold again to give nice, clean lines.

#### Step 6: Display Pillow

For a perfectly styled bed, you cannot forget the display pillows! Place two sets of pillows next to each other standing up against the headboard. Next, add the decorative pillows. Remember that these pillows should resemble a triangle formation. You also want to make sure all the colours and patterns complement each other. The pillows should not be placed on the folded back quilt.

#### Step 7: Decorative Throw

Lastly, use a decorative throw. We love using throws as we believe that they finish/complete a bed. You can either tuck the throw underneath the folded back quilt or you can drape it over the end of the bed. Both look really good – it really is just personal preference.
