

#### CAN I BUY PROPERTY SUBJECT TO SALE?

On the other hand, if you insist on buying subject to sale, be sure to take into account the additional risk and be prepared for disappointment. You could also try to find off-market properties where the seller may be happy to accommodate your condition.


# PEACH & MUSTARD GLAZED HAM

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- Billy's Ham on the Bone
- Meat at Billy's Peach & Mustard Ham Glaze

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Preheat your oven to 160°C. Prepare the ham for glazing by carefully removing the rind. You do this by gently sliding the tips of your fingers backwards & forwards between the rind & fat, gently pulling the rind away as you go.
- 2. Carefully score the fat in a decorative pattern being careful not to cut into the ham itself. Our butchers are always happy to do this for you in advance to help save you time & effort.
- 3. Place your ham in a roasting dish & using a basting brush, apply the glaze mixture liberally all over your ham (at least 3/4 of the jar).
- 4. Place ham in a roasting dish & add 1 or 2 cups of water to the base of the dish to help the ham retain moisture. Bake for 1-2 hours depending on the size of your ham. A 5kg ham will take about 1-1.5 hours. A 10kg ham about 2 hours.
- 5. Brush on more glaze every 25 minutes or so, ensuring there's 1 cup of water in the roasting dish at all times The ham is ready when the glaze has turned a lovely golden brown colour.

# SHORT BREAD

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1. 250 grams of butter
- 2. 2 tablespoons rice flour
- 3. 1/3 cup of icing sugar
- 4. 2 cups of plain flour

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Rub soft butter into your dry ingredients firmly till all ingredients come together (you can use a food processer if you prefer using cold butter).
- 2. Rolled out onto a floured surface about 7mm using your desired cookie cutter.
- 3. Place onto a greased cookie tray and bake in a pre-heated slow oven 120 degree. Baking time will depend on thickness and size of cookie cutter.

A good rule is to make sure the shortbread is firm to touch leaving no fingerprints.

4. Leave to cool on the tray before moving. While your cookies are cooling you can make some royal icing by using 1 egg white and hand mixing with sifted icing sugar till you reach a medium consistency that is pipeable, like a simple squiggly line and pop on some Christmas sprinkles, they will set in around 20 minutes.

You can purchase disposable piping bags or just use a small glad bag and using scissors snip the tiniest corner off to pipe with.

There is no set measurement here as each egg white is different so therefore so is the amount of icing sugar but have about a cup on hand.

# SWEET BAKED SALMON

#### **INGREDIENTS**


- 1x side fresh Salmon skin off
- 1/4 cup soy sauce
- 1/4 cup cooking sake
- 1/4 cup mirin
- 1/4 cup castor sugar
- 1 tbs crushed ginger

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Tell your fish monger how many people you're feeding, and they can weigh the Salmon accordingly. 200g per adult is a good guide.
- 2. Combine all ingredients (except fish) and stir thoroughly.
- Place Salmon in large oven proof dish (large enough for Salmon to lay flat. Cut off tail piece if necessary).
- 4. Pour ingredients over Salmon until mostly covered (you may not use all of it, depending on the size of your dish).
- 5. Marinate in fridge for a few hours (or as long as time permits).
- 6. Bake in pre-heated 190-degree oven for 20 minutes. Check consistency of flesh, and if it's too undercooked for your liking, cook for a further 5-10 minutes. Flesh should easily flake apart when ready.
- 7. This marinade can be used for single portions of Salmon, just use a smaller dish and less marinade. Excess marinade can be stored in the fridge for months.
- 8. Serve with rice and/or fresh greens.







